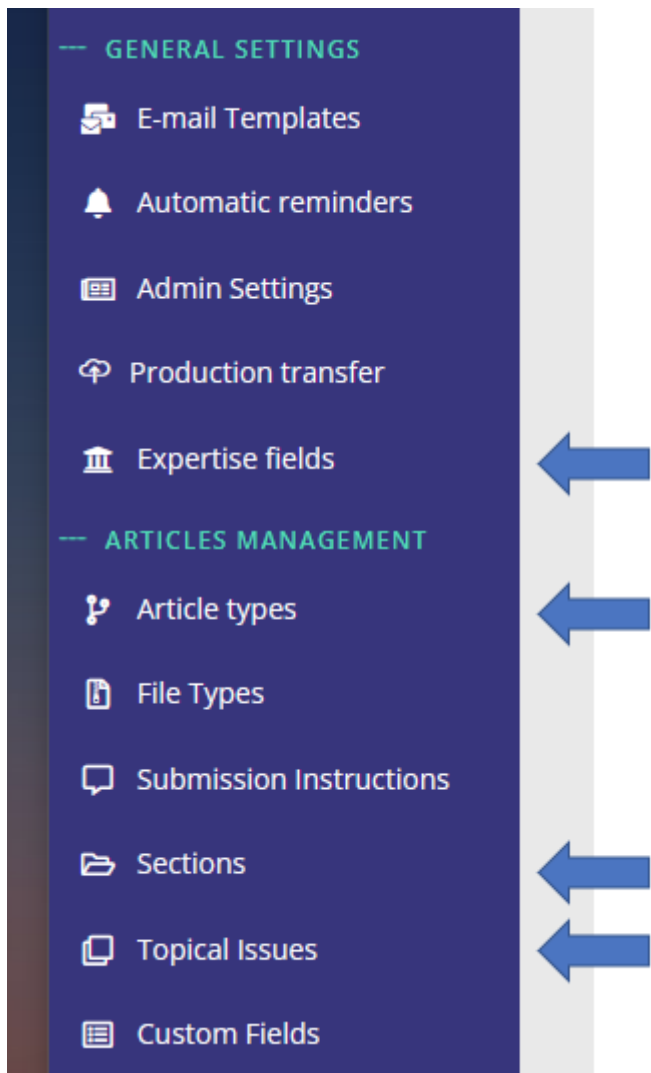


Standard categorizations

Nestor provides a wide choice of tools to categorize articles:



For a specific article, categories are available and may be corrected in the [metadata module](#).

Category name	Particularities
Expertise fields	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tree structure• Used to categorize articles <u>and</u> users, to improve editors/referees matches for a given article

Article types	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Flat list• Used for workflow configuration, see article type configuration.
Sections	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Flat list
Topical issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Flat list

These categories may be used in combination to:

- handle specific workflows (especially article types and [custom fields](#))
- perform [specific searches](#) on articles
- display [visual flags](#) on article pages and article lists
- [process data](#) about your journal
